Premiere at Dressage Cappeln International successful

Right from her first start after her „pregnancy break“

Weihegold OLD starts with an 80 percent victory. Since her third victory in the World Cup, at the beginning of April of this year in Gothenburg/SWE, also had the Olympic gold decorated black mare for embryo transfer paused. Now she starts, to the joy of her rider Isabell Werth, with 80,913 percent in the Grand Prix of Dressage Cappeln International.

Second place went to Victoria Max-Theurer with 72.043 percent on her Blind Date: „I am super, super satisfied with „Beate“ (stable name from Blind Date - note of the editors), which is after a longer period of time „I’ve been very impressed by our competition here.“ A few little things would have cost points and also a fly, „which Beate had been in her belly. But in the walk tour, she beat them away with their hind legs,“ Victoria Max-Theurer smiles understandingly. The EM-fifths and World Championships sixth from Austria also brought for the first time DSP Quantaz to the start. „It’s a young partnership and our fifth place with 70 percent today. I’m really enthusiastic about the motivation and the power of Quantaz, who possesses an incredible potential and with whom I’m growing together more and more now.“

Third place went to Victoria Max-Theurer’s compatriot Florian Bacher his Fidertraum (70.652 percent). Victoria Michalke was fourth at the their Novia G (70.370 percent).

In sixth and seventh place were, from an Austrian point of view Belinda Weinbauer/AUT with Fräulein Auguste MJ and Astrid Neumayer at the Sir Simon.
